Mr. Connarton:

I AM on the Public Relations Committee for St. John the Evangelist Church Annual Spring Festival, which is located at 2254 MASS. AVE., CAMB. On the advise of Mr. Thomas Danahy, I am writing to request a petition to be presented at the next City Council meeting on behalf of St. John the Evangelist Church.

The Petition is as follows: St. John's would like to have a nylon banner announcing the Spring Festival Annually. The banner measures 3'6" x 30'. It will extend from the front of the church building to side of the two utility poles at the sidewalk edge (in front of the Church). The banner will be over Church property with the exception of the sidewalk, which is approximately five feet.

One of the poles is owned by Comm. Electric Company. They have already agreed to give their permission under one condition: they want a letter, which will be drafted by Comm Elec., signed by the City Council absolving them (Comm Elec.) from any liability resulting from the banner being hung on their pole.

The second pole is owned by the M.B.T.A. We are still waiting on a response from them.

The festival starts May 18th; we would be grateful to the City Council and to you for your help in this matter. If there are any questions please feel free to call me (661-3069) or Fr. Curran (541-4880) at your convenience.
