WHEREAS: Listed on the roster of the City of Cambridge prioritized concerns is the mobile safety of its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS: Freedom to move about from one area to another without fear of physical harm due to the deteriorated condition of various streets and sidewalks is a critical issue; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council does hereby request the prompt attention of the Public Works Department to remedy these unsatisfactory conditions wherever they exist, namely: Grant Street, no sidewalk and muddy; Bay Street, large pot hole near handicap ramp; Elmer Street, very poor condition; 83 Howard at Kinnaird, cracked sidewalk; Albany Street, bad condition; Amesbury Street, huge pothole outside the Cambridge Hyatt Hotel.
