In keeping with the underdog theme, the Panthers have been led by 5-foot-7 senior guard Charles Lagoa. He led the team in scoring during the regular season and hasn't let up in the tournament. In his last two games, Lagoa has scored 40 points, grabbed 17 rebounds and dished out 22 assists.

His main targets are wing players, Jamaal Gaitor, Pierre Sully and Demetrius Warren. Gaitor is the prototypical 3-point specialist. Sully is a slasher who knows how to get to the hoop and Warren combined the best of both worlds.

Six-foot-eight sophomore center Keich Butler has some surprising assets for someone so tall at such a young age. He can run the floor, has a soft touch in the paint, but best of all has a great instinct for blocking shots without fouling. Reserve forward Jerome Platt has made his presence felt on the glass in the tournament, his offensive rebound bucket with 11 seconds propelled his team past Watertown in the sectional semifinals.
