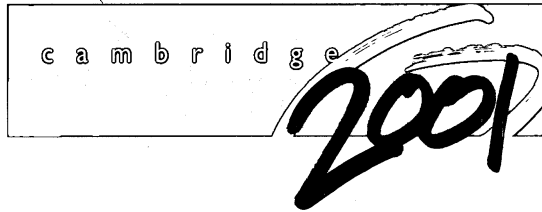

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$20,000 to the Grant Fund License Commission (Consumers' Council) Salary & Wages Account (\$13,500), Travel & Training Account (\$1,500) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$5,000). During the FY02 budget process a partial grant of \$27,000 from the Attorney General's Office was appropriated. This additional appropriation brings the total Attorney General's grant award to \$47,000, equal to what has been appropriated in past years. The funds will be used for a part time mediator/special project assistant, training, and a low student work study contract.
