In Board of Aldermen, Sept-th 1880

The Standing Committee on Roads & Bridges to which was referred the petition of the Committee of Old Cambridge Baptist Church, by James H. Thayer, asking that a street crossing may be laid across Harvard Street, opposite the Main Entrance of the Church, Your Committee would report that there is now a crossing near this point opposite Ware Street, & the public would be accommodated by another also near this Point opposite Prescott Street, but in as much as the petitioners desire the crossing opposite the Church entrance, Your Committee recommend that the same be laid at the Public expense when the petitioners have furnished the materials
