COUNCILLOR TOOMEY

WHEREAS: On April 7, 1991, the people of Cambridge gathered to honor the brave men and women from Cambridge who fought in the Persian Gulf War against Sadaam Hussein's tyranny and oppression; and

WHEREAS: In the past month we have witnessed the President's callous disregard for the plight of the Kurds who have lived for many years under Hussein's tyranny and oppression; and

WHEREAS: The Kurdish people had the right to expect the assistance of the United States in overthrowing Hussein's tyranny and oppression; and

WHEREAS: Immediate and massive humanitarian relief is required to stop the death by hunger of thousands of Kurdish men, women and children; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record of supporting the goals for which its residents have so bravely fought in the Persian Gulf War, and urges the President to live up to his implicit commitments made to the Kurdish people.
