- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Timothy F. White, retired Chief of the Cambridge Fire Department and a life long resident; and
- WHEREAS: Chief White attended local public schools, graduating from the former Rindge Technical High School in 1913 and later served his country during World War I as a member of the United States Army serving with the 55th Artillery Division; and
- WHEREAS: Chief White began his forty year career with the Department in 1919 and through promotional examination held every rank up to and including Chief, a position he maintained from 1954 to 1959; and
- WHEREAS: Shortly after his retirement Chief White was appointed to the Cambridge Water Board and served on that board for twenty-five years; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the White family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
