This is in reference to your communication of April 17, 1970 relative to the Council Order of April 13, 1970 pertaining to the establishment of a teen drop-in center in the Cambridgeport area.

Please be advised that a meeting took place last evening, April 30, 1970, at the C. E. O. C. Cambridgeport Neighborhood Planning Office at which time representatives of various groups including teen-agers, Cambridgeport Planning Team, C. E. O. C., and Recreation Department were present. It was agreed by all that a space committee be organized to look into the possibilities for locating a teen center in this area.

Secondly, it was agreed that, if necessary, the Neighborhood Planning Team would organize a money-raising program to match C. E. O. C. funds for the renovations of a site that might be selected.

Finally, please be advised that the Recreation Department is prepared to pay a reasonable rent, staff, equip, and operate a teen center in this neighborhood, if and when a suitable site is located.
