WHEREAS:

Dog feces on sidewalks and in other public places constitute a serious risk to the public health and safety of Cambridge citizens, especially children, and a considerable inconvenience and annoyance; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager request the Animal Commission, after consulting with the Law, Health, Police, and Public Works Departments and interested citizens and groups, and after studying the experience and laws of other cities, to draft and submit to the City Council for consideration and public hearing a "pooper scooper" ordinance, to require dog owners to remove their dogs' feces from sidewalks and other public places.
