Dear Mr. Corcoran:

It is the recommendation of the City Manager's Committee for Area III that the management and fiscal responsibilities for the Langley Teen Center be transferred from the Recreation Department to the Youth Resources Bureau.

It is also recommended that the sum of thirty-thousand dollars (\$30,000.00), presently, in the Recreation Account for the Langley Teen Center, be transferred to the Youth Resources Bureau's Account and that this be introduced as a resolution for City Council action at its regular meeting on Monday, March 12, 1973.

Paul Cowles, Director of Recreation, all of the Agency and Department Heads, represented on the Committee, area young people and adults preparing for the opening of the Center concur in this recommendation.

It is the opinion of this writer and the Committee that the Langley Teen Center be opened as soon as comprehensive preparations are completed in order that the tangible needs of the youth of the area be met. It is essential that the community be aware, by this immediate action, that their government is responsive and is aware of its responsibility to meet those needs.

This area of our city is going through a series of difficulties that have already had tragic consequences. It is the responsibility of this committee, of all of our citizens, and of government to take




Subject Langley Teen Center


Following our discussion this date, we recommend the Langley Center be re-opened effective Thursday, February 15, 1973, for planning purposes, and staffed by Youth Resources Bureau.

Furthermore, we recommend the 1973-74 budget allocation of Youth Resources Bureau be increased by \$30,000. at the expense of the Recreation Department F-10 Account to provide for the financial commitments for the operation of this center.

In addition, Youth Resources Bureau intends to operate this as a multi-service center, and specific programming will be announced after planning discussions are completed.

Finally, we recognize that Cambridge Redevelopment Authority must give approval to this plan, and accordingly, Mr. Saravelas will hope to gain this approval.

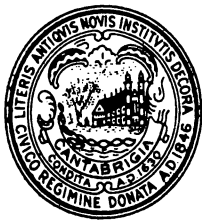
Subject Transfer of Funds

To the Honorable, the City Council:


