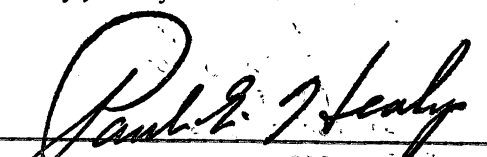
IN CITY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS: Throughout the past forty-five years Carl Barron, Owner and President of Putnam Furniture Leasing Company, Inc., has been extremely active in many civic, business and philanthropic pursuits; and
- WHEREAS: Carl has long been a strong advocate for a more viable business community within Central Square, serving for the past several years as President of the Central Square Group, as well as being a regular participant of the Central Square Committee, a special appointed sub-committee of the City Council, which worked diligently for many months addressing the concerns of the business people and residents of the Central Square area, working to find ways to which it could become a vibrant commercial shopping center; and
- WHEREAS: Carl believes strongly about not only Central Square, but about Cambridge in general, always offering his support, advice and, when necessary, his funds to improve the quality of life in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Carl has devoted much of his time working on projects which are designed to help those individuals who are less fortunate, programs such as the Alcoholic Center at 240 Albany Street, as well as being one of the prime movers on legislation which enacted into law entitled the "Drug Paraphernalia Bill", which prohibits the sale of drug related equipment; a bill which Carl felt strongly about and testified for before the Massachusetts Legislature; now therefore be it

Barron for his forty-five years of continuous activity within the Cambridge community and for his outstanding achievements in the business, civic and philanthropic endeavors with which he has been so closely associated; and be it further
