That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the appropriate officials of Harvard University as to the possibility of the City of Cambridge leasing on a short-term basis the site of the Gulf Station at Harvard Street and Massachusetts Avenue; the parking lots at DeWolfe Street; available lots on Oxford Street and any other sites which Harvard may own or control with the objective of alleviating the parking crisis, which the area around Harvard Square will suffer during the next few years because of the temporary loss of spaces from the construction of Parcel 1B and Mount Auburn Place; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult other land owners in the Harvard Square area with the same objective in mind.
