That the Committee on Ordinances be directed to prepare and report in print, as soon as may be, a new arrangement of all City Ordinances in force at this date, in a consolidated form, with authority to omit redundant enactments, and those which have ceased to have any effect or influence on existing rights; to reject superfluous words, and condense into a concise and comprehensive form all circuitous, tautological and ambiguous phraseology; and to suggest any mistakes, omissions, inconsistencies and imperfections that may appear in the Ordinances to be consolidated and arranged.

The expense thereof to be charged to Appropriation for Incidental Expenses.

the words "or before", and by adding at  
the end of the last line, the words,  
"and whenever any payment is so made  
"before the 30th day of November, interest  
"shall be paid thereon at the rate of  
"Six per centum per annum, by the Com-  
"missioners on the Sinking Funds, from  
"the time of said payment until said  
"30th, day of November"
