Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The density of traffic on Hancock Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Harvard Street, particularly trucks, seems to have increased in the last couple of years.

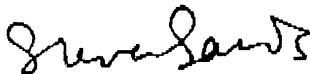
Perhaps this is due to its now being the only direct route in the area without traffic lights between Mass. Ave. and Broadway, or to the elimination of truck traffic of Prospect Street (increasing pressure on parallel streets), or to an increase in traffic generally.

In any case, the truck traffic on Hancock Street, a narrow street with parking on both sides, which runs along a playground for young children (below age 12), now presents a hazard to the children.

We would be grateful, for the children's sake especially, if the Council would install speed bumps, or better still, ban trucks from this stretch of Hancock Street.
