

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Dec 15 1885

Ordered,

That the City Engineer be authorized and instructed to renumber Green Street upon the following plan, to wit: "Divide the frontage into $12\frac{1}{2}$ feet spaces, and then issue the numbers for 20 feet spaces, reserving between the cross streets the difference between ^{one} $12\frac{1}{2}$ feet spaces and the 20 feet spaces for future re-numbering. Also, that he be authorized and instructed to number Mercer Circle, by giving one number to each 20 feet space. The re-numbering of said Green Street, and the numbering of said Mercer Circle, are shown upon plans thereof on file in the City Engineer's office.

The City Engineer is further authorized to furnish all necessary information as to the numbers required under the provisions of this order.
