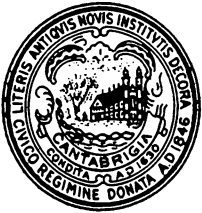
As soon as I have received an answer from the MDC, I will notify you.

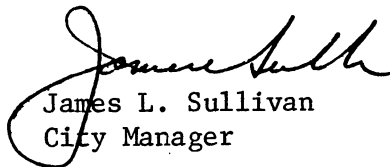
