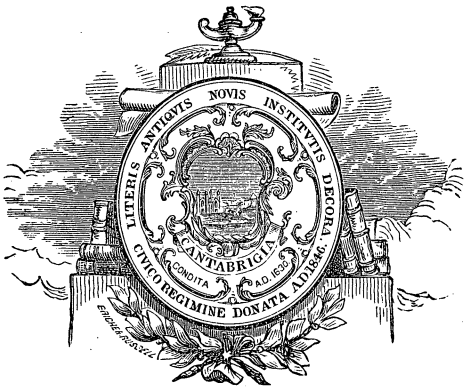

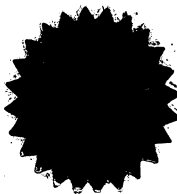
We, the Undersigned, owners of lands on *Surrey Street*
