In Board of Aldermen, June 7 1882

Ordered,

That the Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges be and hereby is authorized and instructed to cause street crossing to be laid as follows:—

1 Across Columbia street from the northern side of Washington street, as prayed for by

Ally. D. Pearson & others.

Take out the blocks from flagging

To extend the half crossing on North Avenue at Meacham street, across the street, as prayed for by F. W. Wardwell & others.

3 Across Cambridge street, on the northern side of Norfolk street, as prayed for by W. L. Lockhart and others.

4 Across Pleasant street at Pleasant place, as prayed for by Pelham Bonney and others.

5 Across Harvard street, from no. 400 to the south-east entrance to the college grounds, - on said street, as prayed for by John Holmes and others.

6 Across Linnaean street, from Aven to Aven Hill street, as prayed for by W. F. Cullen & others.

7 From the northern side of Main street at its junction with Austin. The same to replace the present defective crossing.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the proper appropriations.
