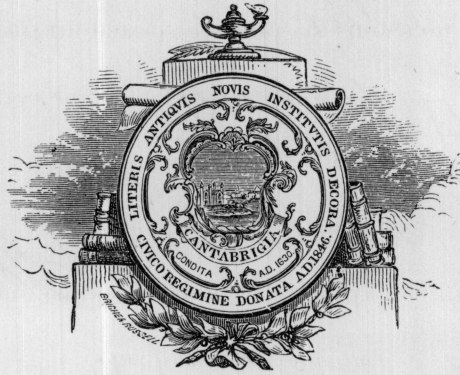

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

Norfolk Street
be widened on its easterly
side, between Austin and Washington Sts
by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City
Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on the easterly side of
Norfolk Street
between Austin and Washington Sts,

as is included between the ^{red and black} lines shown on a plan of Norfolk St,
Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated — and now before this

Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said Norfolk
Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said widening be estimated and awarded as follows:
