- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Louis Agneta on June 23, 1980 at the age of seventy-four years; and
- WHEREAS: Louis Agneta will always be remembered for the role that he played in promoting new elderly housing and for his work at the City Council where he fought for legislation to protect the elderly and low income groups from the ravages of inflation; and
- WHEREAS: "Luke" was involved in many community organizations such as the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee which he served as President as well as serving as a member of the Board of Directors of the Somerville-Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee and he was also extremely active with the Cambridge Committee on Elders, Inc; and
- WHEREAS: Louis "Luke" Agneta was a well liked, loveable person who was respected for his neighborhood and community work, a respect which culminated in a "Luke Agneta Day, July 21, 1978" which was sponsored by the East Cambridge Community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to the family of Luke Agneta at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Agneta Family on behalf of the entire City Council.
