

City of Cambridge

In the year One Thousand Eight  
Hundred and Sixty-six.

An Ordinance  
in addition to "An Ordinance providing for  
the Care and Management of the Water Works."

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sec. 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to  
draw his order forthwith upon the City  
Treasurer, in favor of the Superintendent  
of the Water Works, for a sum not  
exceeding five hundred dollars; such  
order to be countersigned by the Auditor,  
and the amount thereof to be charged  
to the "Appropriation for the Extension  
of the Water Works."

Sec. 2. The Superintendent of the Water  
Works shall endorse said order; but, in  
view of drawing said money from the Treasury,  
he shall have the same in the hands  
of the City Treasurer to be by him paid upon  
bills made out, certified, and approved from

time to time, in the manner herein  
after provided.

Sec. 3. The Superintendent of the Water  
Works is hereby authorized to make out  
bills, from time to time, in favor of any  
of the workmen temporarily employed  
by him, in the extension of the Water  
Works who may be discharged by him  
on account of leaving the City, or for  
any other cause, so long before the  
regular monthly Pay Day as to render  
it unjust or exceedingly inconvenient  
to delay the payment of the amount  
due for such labor until such Pay Day.  
The Superintendent shall certify such  
bills to be correct and shall lay the  
same before the President of the Water  
Board, or in his absence before the  
President *pro tempore* of said Board  
for his approval and the City  
Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay  
any bills so certified and approved.

Sec. 4. The Superintendent shall  
report at each regular meeting of the  
Water Board the amount of bills so  
certified and approved since the preceding

meeting, and whenever it shall appear  
that the amount of the order mentioned  
in Section first is exhausted, or nearly  
so, the Mayor is hereby authorized to  
draw a further order for an amount  
not exceeding five hundred dollars, and  
so from time to time as may be  
required for the payment of bills  
certified and approved as aforesaid.  
Provided, however, that the aggregate  
amount of such orders, and the sums  
otherwise paid from and charged to  
said Appropriation, shall not exceed  
the amount of said Appropriation.
