RE: Placement of "No Parking" signs on Bellis Circle

Bellis Circle was reconstructed by the Public Works Department which included sidewalks. All existing regulations were reposted on new sign poles.

We received a request from Antone Cardoza who lives at the southwest bend of Bellis Circle to move a corner clearance, No parking sign, to 13'/14' from the corner. After reviewing the situation, we did relocate the sign to 20' from the corner, which would allow Mr. Cardoza to park along his property.

We received a complaint from Ms. Kistiakowsky that Fire and Public works vehicles could not turn the corner. Both Departments were contacted about this concern. Neither Department feels that a 20' corner clearance has or will pose a problem. I am enclosing a copy of the letter we sent we sent to Mr. Kistiakowsky.

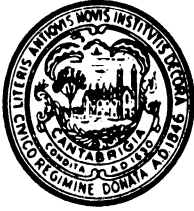
Dear Ms Kistiakowsky,

You recently wrote to Mr. Healy concerning a sign we moved on Bellis Circle. After the reconstruction of the circle there were several signs installed incorrectly. Over a period of time these signs were reinstalled at their correct locations. The most recent signs that we moved was at the request of a councillor for a resident. The sign is 20ft from the corner which is the regulatory distance for that type of sign. Both the Public Works department and the Fire department were contacted concerning the change and neither department feels that they have or will be hampered by this change.
