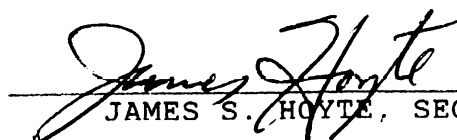
The Secretary of Environmental Affairs herein issues a statement that the Final Environmental Impact Report submitted on the above project adequately and properly complies with the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act (G.L., c.30, s.61-62H) and with its implementing regulations (301 CMR 11.00).

A Draft Section 61 Finding was reviewed in context with the Draft EIR/Final EIR, the Secretary's Certificate on the Draft EIR dated January 4, 1988, the Parking Management Plan and MBTA Ridership/Service Summary, dated February 16, 1988, and Assistant Secretary Davis letter to the MBTA, dated March 9, 1988.

Section 61 Finding

The Section 61 Finding should be amended to include a back up provision, whereby if the predicted mass transit ridership levels are not achieved within a year and sustained for the next five years, then the MEPA Unit will be notified of a project change, pursuant to 301 CMR 11.17, for the express purpose of evaluating alternative parking arrangements.
