To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached please find for your acceptance and appropriation a grant from Attorney General Scott Harshbarger's Office totalling \$65,000.00. The City Council in the FY94 budget process appropriated \$21,280.00 leaving a \$43,720.00 balance which is requested to be appropriated in the License Commission (Consumer Council) Salary & Wages Account \$36,000.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$7,720.00.

This appropriation supports 1 1/2 positions which primary functions are to mediate individual consumer disputes. In 1993, the Consumer Council mediated over 1,500 individual consumer disputes. Those disputes resulted in refunds or savings to consumers totalling over \$125,000.00
