Dear Mr. Healy,

I have investigated the parking lot for Star Market located between Aberdeen Avenue and Homer Avenue, as it relates to the conditions set forth by the Traffic Department and as requested by the City Council. My investigation revealed that (1). A gate was erected on the Right-Of-Way to their property which is closed from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM nightly (2.) Signs were erected directing traffic to this parking lot and (3). I have talked to Mr. William Fulginit, 25 Homer Avenue who was the only objector at the City Council meeting and he is satisfied with that the gate is stopping the drivers from using this lot as a shortcut from Mt. Auburn Street to Aberdeen Avenue and vice versa during the night time.

These were the conditions set forth at the City Council meeting and I can safely state that the owner of this property has complied with the Traffic Department's requests and we will continue to periodically check this area to make sure that no changes are made in the future.
