WHEREAS: Maintaining public walkways and access to public transportation facilities in the Harvard Square area is necessary for all citizens and commuters, and handicapped citizens and visitors in particular; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to assign as a high priority the early morning snow removal from the public walkways of the Cambridge Common, Dawes Island, and Massachusetts Avenue and Garden Street along the Old Burying Grounds in Harvard Square.


