COUNCILLOR D. SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: Arthur D. Little, Inc. is reported to be planning to expand its Acorn Park facilities for nerve and blister agent testing by additional construction; and
- WHEREAS: Such additional facilities and any similar uses elsewhere, would constitute an even more serious threat to the public health and safety than the current activities which the city is attempting to halt; and
- WHEREAS: An appropriate legal mechanism for preventing such additional construction is an amendment to the city's zoning ordinance; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Community Development Department, with the assistance of the Law Department, to prepare a zoning change proposal prohibiting in all zoning districts of Cambridge any use which involves the testing, manufacturing, storage, transportation, or disposal of nerve or blister agents; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager submit this draft proposal to the City Council for its consideration as soon as possible, so that it can be advertised before any building permit is obtained.
