Lieutenant Lange, in charge of traffic, has been instructed to strictly enforce all handicapped parking locations.

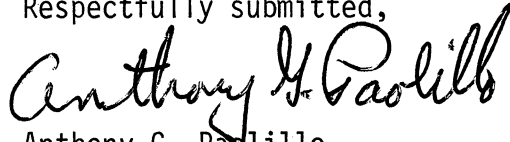

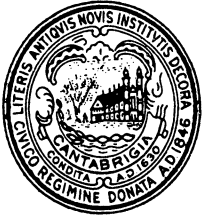
