Florence was born on the tropical island of St. Croix, United States Virgin Islands. She is the third daughter of the (late) Darnley and Athalie Petersen, who trained her "in the ways of the Lord".

Florence accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior on February 18, 1983; upon relocating to Boston, she joined St. Paul African Methodist Episcopal Church in March 1987. She responded to God's call to ministry on April 2, 1990, and entered the ministry under the spiritual leadership of Pastor LeRoy Attles. Florence was ordained an Itinerant Deacon of the Church, on April 29, 1995, and received her Elders Orders on April 21, 2001.

Florence's academic training for ministry includes the receipt of a Masters of Divinity from Andover Newton Theological School. She was inducted into the Jonathan Edwards Honor society of Andover Newton in April 2000. She also possesses a Bachelor of Science in Foods and Nutrition from Carnegie-Mellon University and a Masters of Science from Pennsylvania State University.
