In amendment to an ordinance  
formerly entitled: "The General  
Ordinances of the City of Cam-  
bridge" as revised in 1972 and now  
designated as "The Code of the  
City of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter Two entitled: "Ad-  
ministration" Article XVI entitled:  
"Cambridge Historical Com-  
mission" is hereby amended by  
adding at the end thereof of section  
2-147 entitled: "Powers and  
Duties of the Commission" a new  
sub-section (j) entitled: "Proced-  
ures for Demolition of an -  
Significant Building as Determined  
by the Cambridge Historical  
Commission to be Historically of  
Architecturally Detrimental"
