In response to Awaiting Report No. 03-36 regarding a report on a timeline for the renovation of the Concord Avenue Playground, please be advised that the Concord Avenue Playground is in the City's 5-year Capital Plan for renovations. However, due to the extensive park renovation schedule currently planned, the renovations to Concord Avenue Playground has not yet been scheduled. Below I have listed the tentative schedule for other park renovations:

- Franklin Street Park – Construction underway
- Maple Avenue Playground -- Construction to begin summer 2003
- Lopez Playground -- Construction to begin spring 2003
- Lowell School -- Design development underway
- Dana Park -- Design development to begin spring 2003
- Alden Playground/Baldwin School -- Design development to begin summer 2003
- Squirrel Brand Park -- Construction to begin fall 2003
- 238 Broadway/Harvard Street Park -- Construction to begin 2004
- Donnelly Field -- Design development underway
- Russell Field -- Design Development underway
- Fresh Pond Northeast Sector Project and William Maher Park -- Construction to begin in 2004

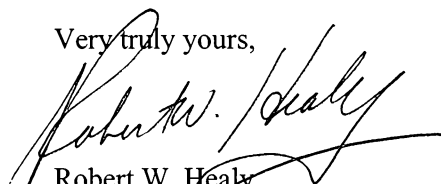
