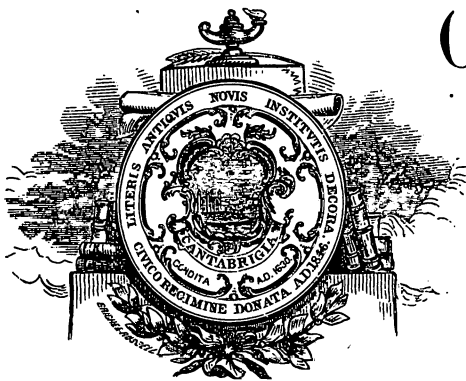




# CITY OF CAMBRIDGE. 17

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 28, 1874,

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Spaulcock Street*  
*between Main & Franklin Sts.,*  
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *twenty six feet,*  
in width between

*Main and Franklin Sts.,*  
included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

*J. G. Chase, City Engineer,*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *And*  
*that three months be allowed for removal of*  
*all obstructions standing thereon -*
