COUNCILLOR FRISOLI

- WHEREAS: On September 18, 1978, the Honorable Cambridge City Council requested the City Manager to instruct the Health Department to inspect all homes near the new public works facility for rodents and vermin; and
- WHEREAS: This inspection has failed to occur due to the poor administrative ability of the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: It is unlawful and immoral for the City of Cambridge to be responsible for the rodents and vermin which are invading the homes of human beings; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to forthwith order the Head of the City Health Department to conduct a professional survey of the aforementioned area and to forward a copy of this Council order and the respective Council order of September 18, 1978, to the Head of the Health Department for action.
