In the year One Thousand Eight hundred & fifty Eight
An Ordinance

In relation to the Care & management of Dana Library.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge as follows:

Sec. 1 The Library recently received of the Cambridge
Athenaeum shall be called the Dana Library

Sec. 11 There shall be chosen by ballot in Convention, at the
commencement of Each Municipal Year a Committee
styled the Committee on Dana Library to consist of
two members of the Board of Aldermen & three members
of the Common Council, who shall have the Care and
management of the Library & make such rules &
regulations concerning the Same as they may deem
Expedient.

Sec. 111. Said Committee shall after deducting an
amount sufficient to defray the Expense of the
Care of the Library, invest the remaining funds
in the purchase of such Books as they may deem sui-
table for the Library.

Sec IV. Said Committee shall Elect a suitable person for Librarian who shall perform the duties of the Office agreeably to the rules & regulations established by Said Committee. He shall receive such Compensation as the Committee shall from time to time determine.

Sec V. Said Committee shall annually at the close of each financial year submit a report in detail, of the condition of the Library, the amount received by subscription or otherwise & the amount Expended by them during the year.
