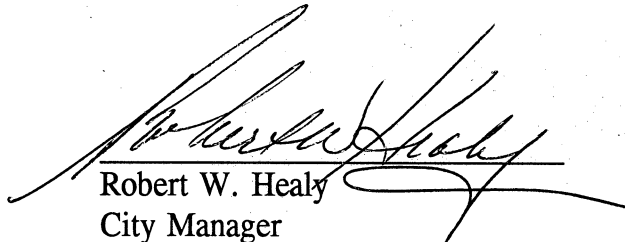

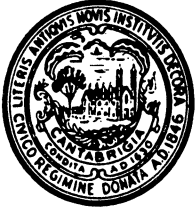

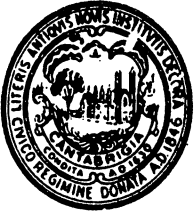

Re: Jitney Application- U.S. Shuttle, Inc.

This is to inform you that the License Commission held a hearing on November 28, 1995 on the jitney application of U. S. Shuttle, Inc.. The application was filed on November 6, 1995 and a final decision must be made by the City Council by January 6, 1996.

The application is for four vehicles to travel along the streets listed except that certain streets have been eliminated due to Traffic and Parking recommendations and others added. See Appendix A for lists of streets. The shuttle will travel from other towns to Cambridge on those streets listed, to pick up guests at the hotels in Cambridge, to the airport. These trips will be on a fixed route as listed.

The License Commission voted 3-0, on November 30, 1995, to recommend to you that the City Council deny this application. The reasons for denial are as follows:

- 1) The applicant did not present a need for this service. No documents, evidence, or statistics were presented to show a need for additional services in the area.
- 2) Currently there are numerous services already provided in the city, i.e., Mount Auburn shuttle, Bolt, Beranak and Newman shuttle, two site-seeing tour trolleys, 248 cabs.
- 3) This Commission have observed up to 25 cabs alone in Harvard Square sitting idle, on both day and evening, without customers. The cab industry would be severely stressed by additional jitney services. Between 50 - 100 (100 when hearing began, 50 were left at start of testimony) cab drivers showed up to our hearing to object to this application. A petition of 340 drivers was presented objecting to this application. A great majority of these cab drivers are Cambridge residents who believe that Cambridge businesses should come first. Other reasons encouraging denial

were lack of need and false statements of enviornmental benefit plus harmful economic impact to cab industry. The presence of three City Councilors at our hearing who testified against this application, suggests that they are concerned about the so-called "New Americans" (cab drivers) who have come to our country to try and make a living. The average cost of a medallion these days is \$70,000.00 plus the cost of the vehicle. Just meeting the cost of the note on the loan is a great burden to these cab drivers.

4) Also evidence was presented by cab drivers and police that U. S. Shuttle has not abided by the law at present. Shuttles have been seen outside hotels awaiting to pick up fares without so-called "SHIPS" forms which are the list of people who have pre-arranged to be taken to the airport by U.S.Shuttle and remaining outside hotels to pick up those who may see the shuttle and ask to board last minute.

I enclose the entire file as presented to our Commission and ask that you submit this to City Council for a hearing. If you need any of our staff to attend the City Council, please let me know.

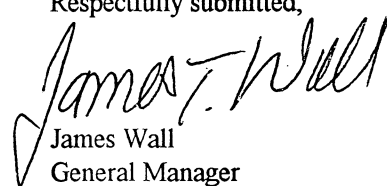
U.S. Shuttle, Inc. of 18 Moore Street, Belmont, Massachusetts, hereby applies for a license to operate motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire over public ways in the city of Cambridge as listed in attached Appendix A.

U.S. Shuttle, Inc. has DPU approved equipment points (places of garaging) in Belmont and Waltham. All drivers have the required DPU certificates. The Criminal History Systems Board has not certified U.S. Shuttle to receive probation reports as it is not a type of business legally authorized to receive these reports. While U.S. Shuttle, Inc. does not have any vehicles carrying more than 14 passengers, if at any future time it will use such vehicles, the drivers will have commercial drivers licenses.

U.S. Shuttle's reason for applying for this license is to operate over public ways in Cambridge through the city en route to and from Logan Airport and hotels and industrial parks in route 128 and western suburban areas. U.S. Shuttle, Inc. proposes to serve similar businesses in Cambridge. The hours of service would be from early morning until late evening. Four vehicles would be used for this service as U.S. Shuttle, Inc., intended to apply for a common carrier regular en route, it expects to serve the general public.

U.S. Shuttle operates vehicles, all which have passed DPU inspection. A hearing and advertising fee of \$110.00 is included.

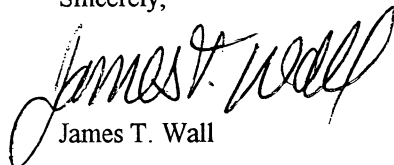

Mr. Crane informed me that in his opinion, there was absolutely no conflict of interest presented.

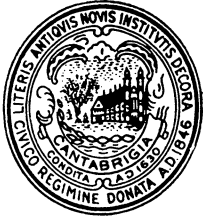

Dear Mr. Scali:

I have reviewed the jitney license application for U.S. Shuttle Inc. to operate a shuttle service from various Cambridge hotels to and from Logan Airport. The list of public ways they have applied for assumes that they have permission to use all or portions of Memorial Drive. It is recommended that J.F. Kennedy Street between Memorial Drive and Mass. Ave. be added to their list of streets which will complete the connection of Eliot Street to Memorial Drive, Mt. Auburn Street and Mass. Ave.

We also recommend that Broadway from Quincy Street to Galileo Galilei Way be deleted from their request. Broadway is primarily residential with three schools and two playgrounds abutting the street and is not recommended or included on other shuttle or siteseeing bus licenses.
