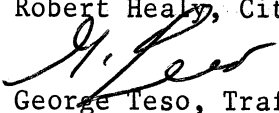

Two signs, warning drivers that heavy trucks are prohibited from using Cameron Avenue have been installed on Massachusetts Avenue facing both approaches to Cameron Avenue. It is our opinion that these signs will adequately warn truck drivers before they turn into Cameron Avenue.

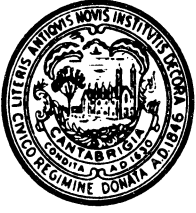
We have also noted that most of the violators who claim they did not see these signs are fully aware of the restriction and take a chance anyway.
