I bought a condo last yr. on Upland Rd., a block from White Hen Pantry & Brueggers (sp?). I love living here but I'm grossed out by all the litter that collects on the sidewalks & gutters along this block. I recently saw a rat on the sidewalk near my house chewing on a piece of litter. Some of the litter is food containers, etc. that pedestrians throw in the street & some is trash that's put out on Sunday for Mon. collection getting blown around.

The alley between the Japanese book store & the apt. bldg next to it is particularly disgusting.

Can anyone tell me if there's an ordinance requiring property owners to keep the street & sidewalk outside their property free of litter. Or to put out trash in secure containers or not to put it out until the morning of collection. If there are any of these ordinances, how are they enforced? Can the owner of the dumpster in the alley next to the bookstore be induced to maintain it properly? Can the mgrs of White Hen & Brueggers be induced to sweep their sidewalks periodically during the day?
