- WHEREAS: This Honorable Body did act unanimously on February 14, 1977 on certain actions giving a "green-light" to the development of Kendall Square; and
- WHEREAS: This Honorable Body did act unanimously on February 14, 1977 to have the City Manager arrange to have performed a census to identify all unemployed and underemployed Cambridge residents; and
- WHEREAS: The development of Kendall Square will result in the creation of at least 3000 new jobs aimed at providing Cambridge residents with upwardly-mobile job opportunities; and
- WHEREAS: The objectives of the Kendall Square urban renewal plan specifically provide for maximizing job opportunities at a variety of skill levels for Cambridge residents; and
- WHEREAS: The real estate marketing program for the Cambridge Center development requires some community mechanism intended to match prospective job opportunities with available Cambridge labor supply; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Redevelopment Authority is prepared to enter into an agreement, and has proposed such an agreement, with the City of Cambridge for the purpose of effectively implementing manpower development and training and affirmative action programs for neighborhood and minority hiring; now, therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager arrange to provide for the prompt development and execution of a strong manpower development training and affirmative action program in order to prepare Cambridge people for placement in upwardly-mobile jobs at a variety of skill levels, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager explore all Federal and State manpower development and training funding sources, including but not limited to CETA, and make application for such funds, as appropriate, in connection with the implementation of the aforementioned program, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge School Department design, implement, continue and expand any and all programs which can prepare our youth for upwardly-mobile job opportunities.
