the following sums are hereby appropriated in the General Fund of the City of Cambridge.



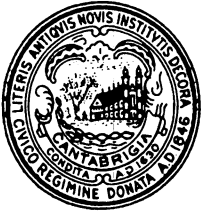

The attached appropriation of \$167,681 for the Police Department is to cover the additional costs of the most recent police contract settlement.
