To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 24, regarding the feasibility of establishing a Police Cadet Program for Cambridge residents, Police Commissioner Perry L. Anderson reports the following:

The Cambridge Police Department currently has several programs for Cambridge residents to become involved with the Police Department.

The Leadership Council provides for community leaders to have direct input and communicate concerns regarding the operation of the Department. The Citizen's Police Academy allows for 18 community members to attend ten weeks of training in the operation of the Police Department. The current group is scheduled to graduate in late October. The Auxiliary Police is a group of 35 - 40 individuals who volunteer their time and energy in assisting, throughout the community, with various functions, events, road races, etc. The Police Explorers is a program for young people aspiring to a career in law enforcement.

The Police Department does not see a need to establish a Police Cadet Program.
