- WHEREAS: The City Council agreed with the concerns expressed at that meeting and requested that the City Manager seek an appropriate revenue source; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council determines life is more valuable than property; the City Manager be and hereby is requested to re-allocate the funds designated for the construction of a pedestrian on-grade crossing at Fort Washington to the construction of an overhead pedestrian walkway at Jefferson Park.
