Contact Communications of Mass., Inc., a Massachusetts corporation, seeks permission from the Department of Public Utilities to provide one-way paging services on station/call sign KNKE 274, in Eastern Massachusetts, with proposed initial transmitter sites in Boston, Amesbury and Worcester (Paxton) on frequency 931.2125 MHZ.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Contact Communications of Massachusetts, Inc. under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate as a Radio Utility, for the operation of a Mobile Radio Utility System for compensation within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The Department will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its hearing room, 1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Monday, December 16, 1991 at 2:00 p.m.
