WHEREAS: The grant will provide support for Cambridge Community Television's *Summer Media Institute* which offers a six-week intensive course in all aspects of media production and presentation. Funds from the CAC grant will support an Artist-In Residence to develop the creative capacity of the students and the quality of the media produced; and

WHEREAS: This exciting artistic project with real community focus will enrich the Cambridge Community; now therefore be it
