The Managers office at Cambridge City Hall recommended that I write to you concerning my problem and that you could petition the City Counsel concerning the matter.

My dilemma is the street we live on is a private way, still everybody parks here. It's convenient to the Stephen James House on one side and on the other you have Dole Publishing in Somerville. With only three houses on the street, there's barely enough parking for Residents, and we can't have them towed unless we want to pay the expenses out of our own pockets. So far I contacted the Traffic Department, Public Works Department, the Mayors Office and finally the Managers Office and no one can help because our street is considered an unaccepted street (Private Way). What I'm asking for is a few signs saying PRIVATE PARKING, RESIDENTS ONLY, TOWED AT OWNERS EXPENSE.

One neighbor is concerned that the city might make Saginaw Ave a public street. In reality it doesn't matter, it seems like it is now except we don't get any services from the city like the public streets do. In the Winter they don't plow, we have our friends do it. In the Summer they don't street clean, and they never clean the sewer unless we call them about the unbearable odor. The only service we do get is garbage pick-up on Mondays. My family has lived on Saginaw Ave for over 25 years and it gets pretty frustrating when you ask for a few signs and all you get is one office passing the buck to another. I would appreciate any assistance you could give on this matter. Looking forward to hearing from you.
