Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.
