Sir:

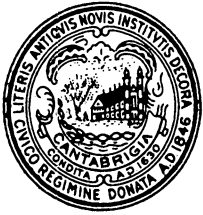


