WHEREAS: The Jewish Women's Archive has recognized three Cambridge women as "Women Who Dared," praising their work as having significant impact on our community; and

WHEREAS: Peggy Charren has been recognized for her work in the area of children's television, forming a non-profit organization called Action for Children's Television, advocating for higher quality, less commercialized children's television programming while fighting censorship, and winning a Peabody Award; and

WHEREAS: Justice Ruth Abrams has been recognized for her service as the first woman justice on the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court, serving from 1978 to 2000, fighting for issues including family leave, medical care, gender equity, and minority rights; and

WHEREAS: Hannah Jukovsky has been recognized for her role as a student at Cambridge Rindge and Latin creating dialog about the Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System (MCAS), leading efforts to inform students and the public about education reform through discussion and teach-ins; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record congratulating Peggy Charren, Ruth Abrams, and Hannah Jukovsky on being named "Women Who Dared" by the Jewish Women's Archive; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Peggy Charren, Ruth Abrams and Hannah Jukovsky on behalf of the entire City Council.
