At a Meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Middlesex holden at Cambridge within and for said County on the first Tuesday of January A.D. 1859.

The Jury empanelled by the Sheriff of the County of Middlesex by virtue of a warrant issued upon the Petition of J. Warren Merrill of Cambridge in said County praying for a Jury to assess the damages sustained by him by reason of the taking his land for the purpose of widening Deanster Street in said Cambridge, by order of the City Council of said City of Cambridge made return of their Verdict to the Court of Common Pleas, and at the term of said Court holden at Lowell within and for said County on the first Tuesday of September last, when and where the said Court after mature deliberation accepted said Verdict — And now the Clerk of said Court of Common Pleas, make return of the Verdict of said Court of Common Pleas, and their adjudication thereon, by which it appears that the said Jury empanelled as aforesaid awarded to the said J. Warren Merrill, the sum of Four hundred and fifty Dollars as his damage sustained as aforesaid and thereupon the said County Commissioners here consider and adjudge that the said Warren Merrill recover against the said City of Cambridge the sum of Four hundred and fifty Dollars and the interest thereon, from the time of making said Verdict. (May 29, 1858) to the adjudication of the said

County Commissioners, (Jan. 3, 1859) amounting to sixteen dollars
