That the Superintendent of Streets be and is hereby ordered to cause Edgestones to be set on the east side of Fifth St from Thorndike to Spring and on Spring St from Fifth to Fourth St and on Fourth St from Spring to Thorndike St the expense of the same to be charged to Incidental Expenses, and assessed according to law. And it is also ordered that the usual order of notice be issued to the abutters.
