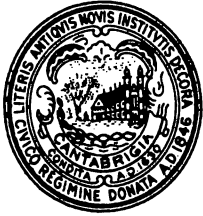
AN ORDER CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975



Department of Health, Education and Welfare has approved the City Hospital's applications for \$77,870 in "Psychiatry - Basic Residency" funds under the auspices of the National Institute of Mental Health.
